- You'll provide invaluable support for artists in recovery and the local arts community

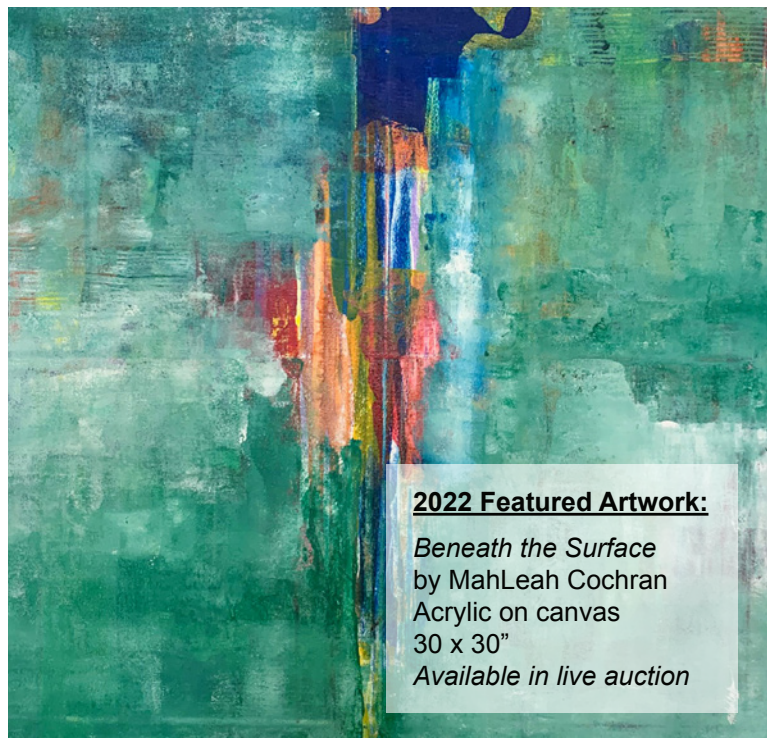
